EES Gets Visit from Ga's First Lady



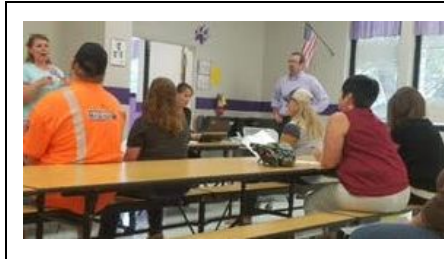
